

DIY Mammal Footprint Tunnel - Small mammal



You will need:

| Juice/milk carton | Paintbrush |
| Thin cardboard | Vegetable oil |
| White paper | Charcoal powder |
| Paper clips | Bait - bird seed |
| Masking tape | |



Cut the top and base from the carton.

Cut a piece of cardboard to fit inside the carton to form a base.

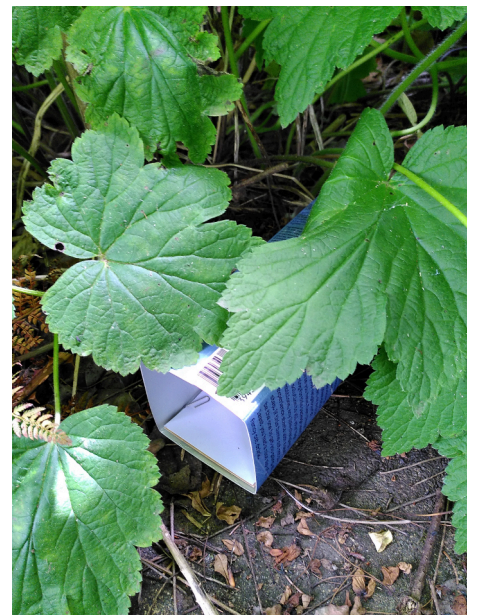
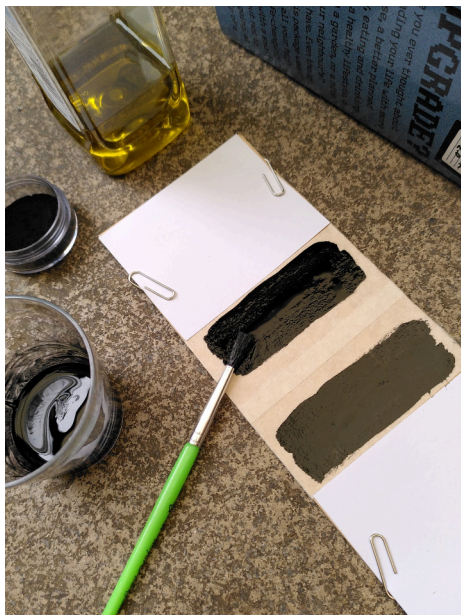
Secure the white paper either end of the base with paper clips.

Cover the middle of the base with masking tape.

Mix the oil and charcoal 50:50 and paint liberally onto the masking tape, leaving a gap in the centre.

Place a few seeds in the centre and slide the base into the tunnel.

Position the tunnel in a spot where small mammals are likely to visit.



Check the tunnel daily, replacing paper and bait as necessary.
